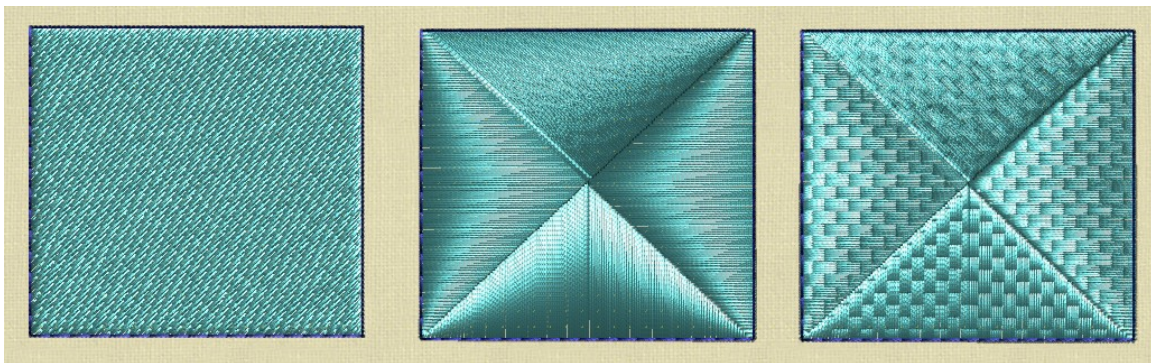

Did you know?

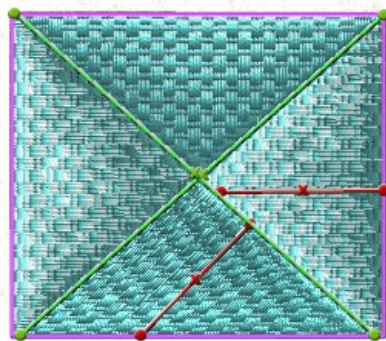
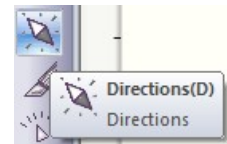
The Divide tool only applies to satin and piping areas.



To create multiple directions of stitches in a step fill area, first change the area to a Satin area. Then use the Divide tool to “cut up” the satin area. Once the area is divided, you can add a pattern to the area. The pattern will follow the satin directions.



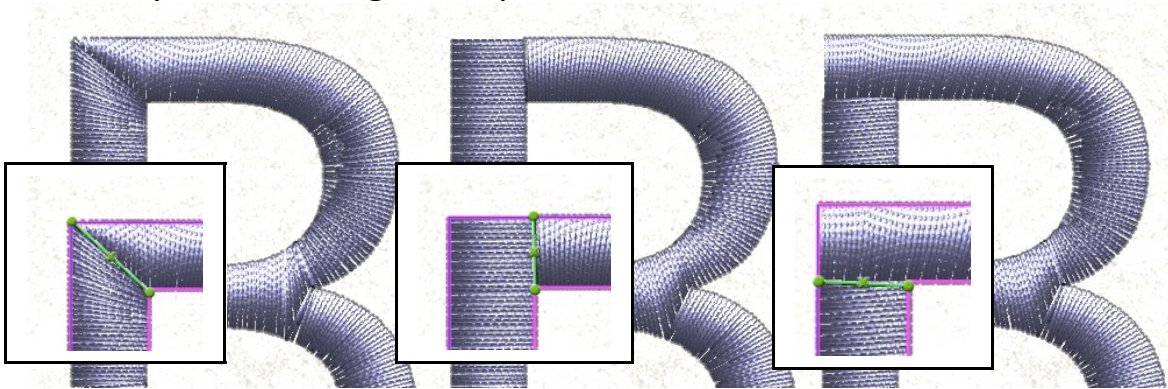
If you don't like the direction of the pattern, use the Direction tool to adjust.



Icon Info: Divide

The Divide tool is very useful when adjusting satin stitch designs such as scrolls and lettering.

With lettering you can choose the style of corner you wish. This makes your lettering more professional.



Simply click on the object you want to divide. Then click and drag a line across the satin stitch. To remove the line, click on the “x” in the middle of the line. A divide line will be green.

For a scroll, Divide will help you correct a satin stitch that is forming around a tight curve. You have complete control over your satin stitches.
