

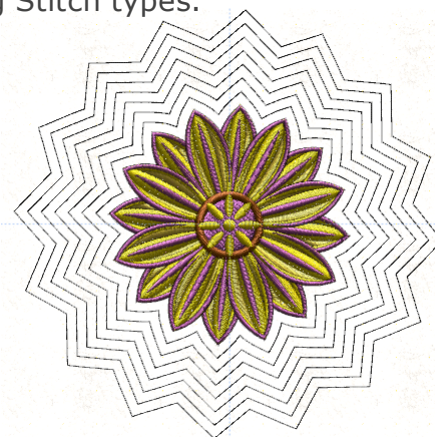
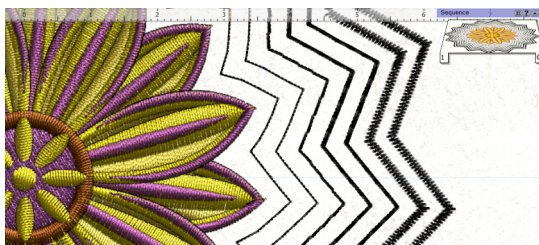

News!

Creative DRAWings® 5 is now available! There are many new features including:

- New **Auto-Border** tool with Satin Serial and Running Stitch types.
 - Create an “echo quilting” effect around your embroidery design. Change the distance between borders and number of borders for your design. Choose a satin, running, double or triple stitch to emphasize your embroidery.



Did you know?

You can change the type of running stitch (single, double or triple) just by changing the Outline parameter in the Tool options.



First, make sure that your measurement options are in metric. To do this, go to **Tools** on the main toolbar. Go to **Options**. On the **General** tab, choose Measurement system **Metric**.

When you choose a running border in your design, notice the Outline parameter of the Tool Options.

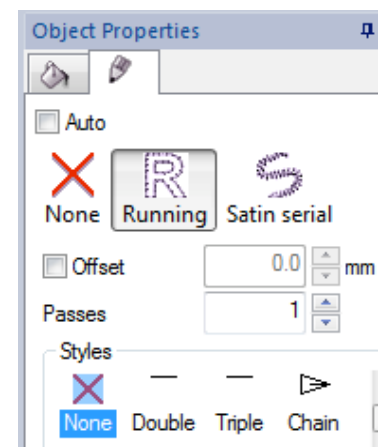
0.1 to 0.4 = Single Running Stitch

0.5 to 0.8 = Double Running Stitch

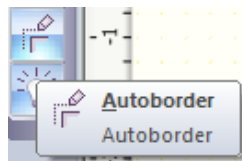
0.9 and above = Triple Running Stitch

Now look at the Object Properties tab. On the pen or border tab, see the Running option chosen. Under Styles, either None “X”, Double or Triple is highlighted.

Change the Outline Parameter to a new setting (use the above guidelines). Enter and see the change in the design as well as in the Object Properties. Try several settings and watch the changes.



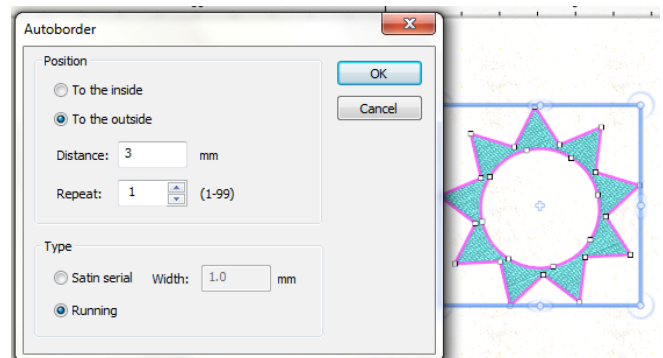
Icon Info: Autoborder



Autoborder is one of the Creative DRAWings® 5. It create an echo effect for your designs.

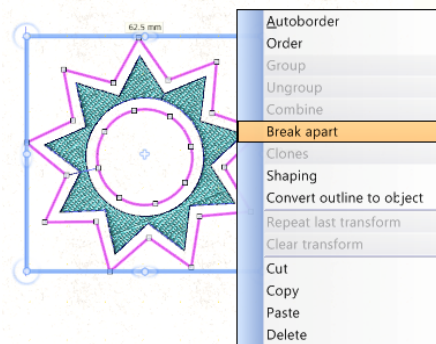
new functions in is now easy to

Simply start with your design. Select your design. Click Autoborder. A window comes up. Choose the position “To the outside”, Distance 3 mm, Repeats 1 and Type Running. OK. If your design is not complete (it has holes in it) you will get a border both on the “outside” of the hole and the “outside” of the design.

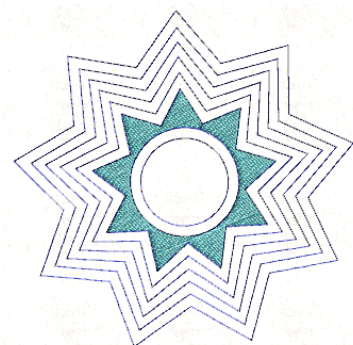


Note: It is a good idea to “test” your border by placing one border first to make sure you get what you want.

If you only want your border on the outside of the design, Select the border. Right click then choose Break apart. Now your border has two parts.



Select the part of your design you want to border. Go back to Autoborder.



Add as many borders as you wish (1-99).

Remember you can change the style of the border line by changing the Outline parameter in the Tool options!
