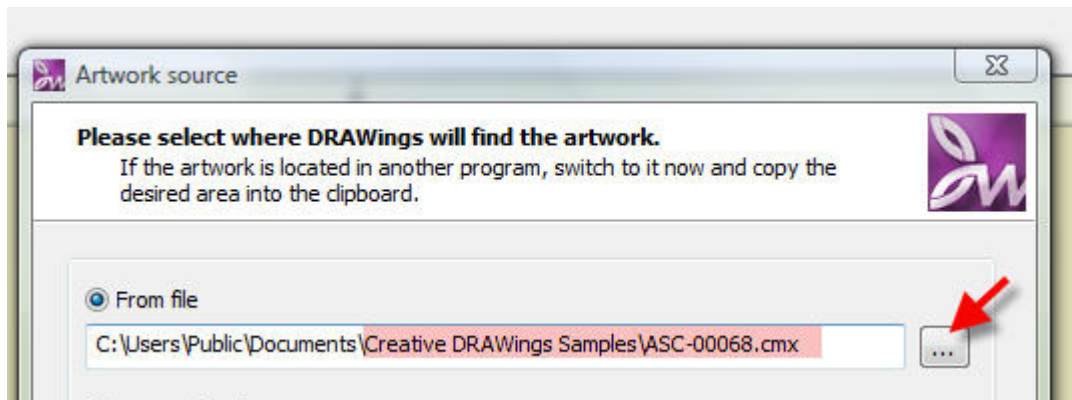


# WRISTBAND

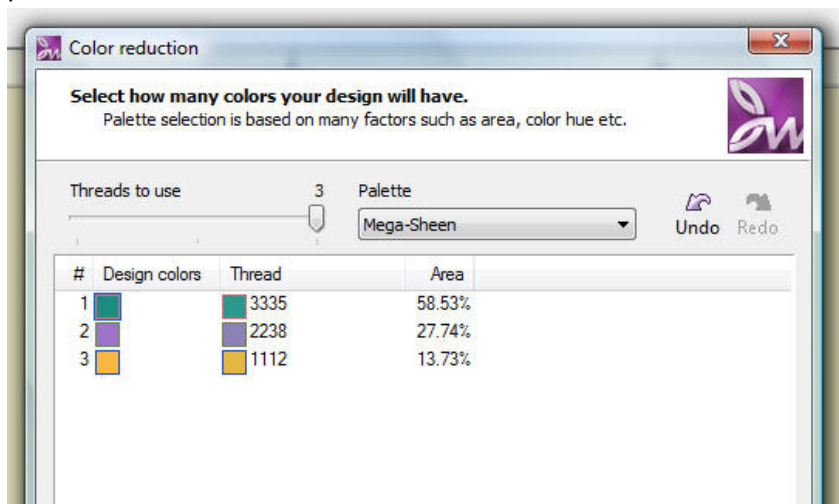
## Creative DRAWings® Design Instructions



1. Open Creative DRAWings®.
2. Left click in the circle next to *From file* in the *Artwork source* box.
3. Look for the file for Creative DRAWings® samples. If you do not see it, left click in the browsing box (3 dots) to find it. Choose design #68.

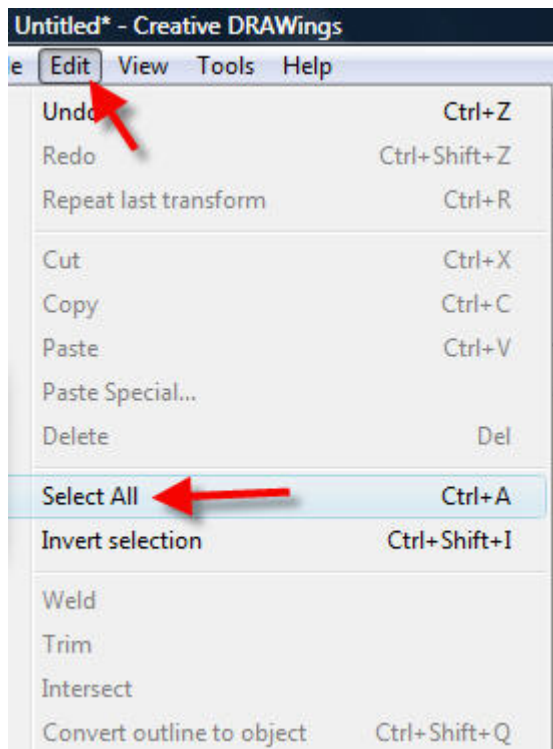


4. For the hoop, select *None*.
5. Choose the desired fabric type and color for your project. I chose tan cotton.
6. Leave the *Color reduction* screen set for 3 colors. I chose *Mega Sheen* from the drop-down menu for the thread *Palette* but you can leave the colors at RGB or change to the thread you prefer.

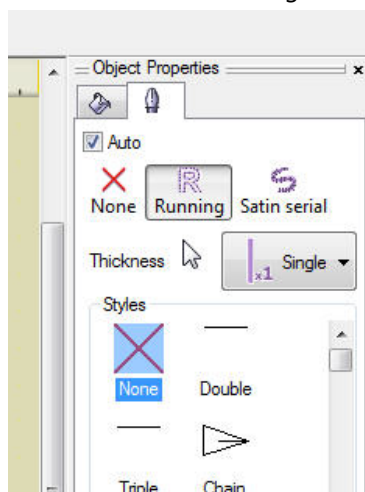


7. Left click on *Finish*. You will see the design in stitches on your workspace.

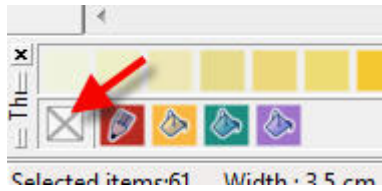
8. Select the entire design by left clicking on the *Edit* tab at the upper left of your screen and then choose *Select All*.



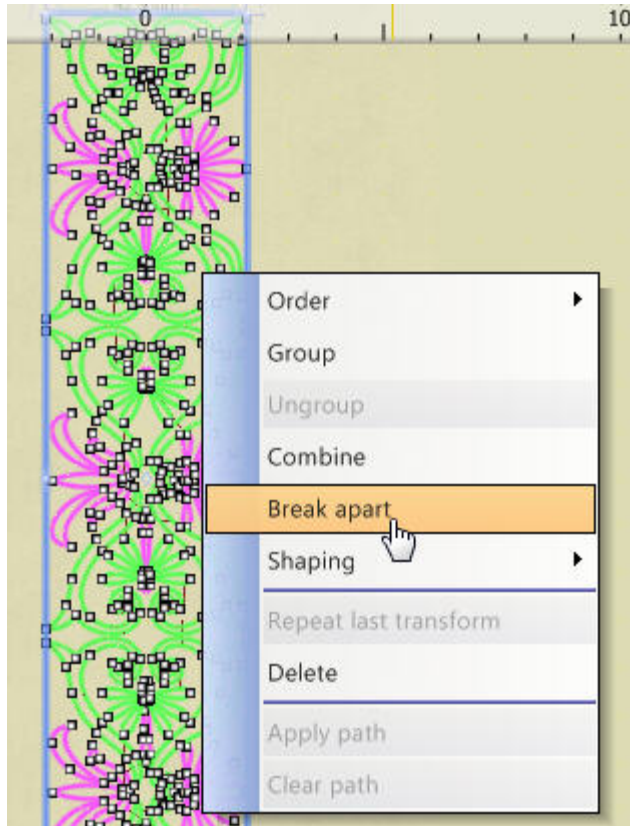
9. Hold down the *Shift* key and left click on a color of the color bar. This will add an outline around all of the objects in the design.
10. Look at the *Object Properties* menu on the right-hand side of the screen and make sure that the outline selected is a *Single Running* stitch.




11. Left click on the X at the bottom left of the color bar to remove all of the fill stitches.

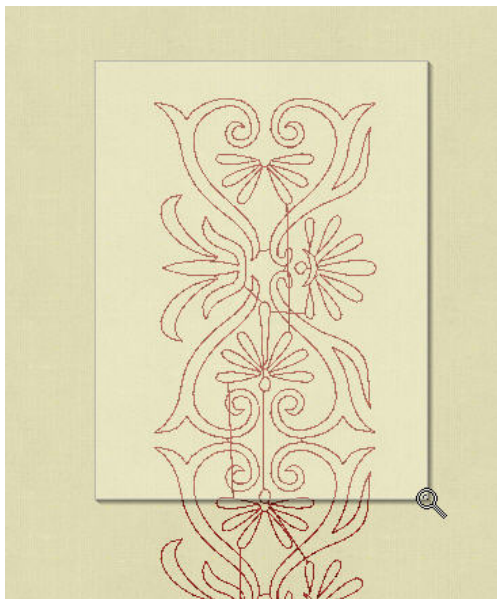



12. While the entire design is still selected, right click. Choose the option *Break apart* from the menu that appears.




13. Left click on the workspace outside of the selection box and the design will appear in outline stitches.

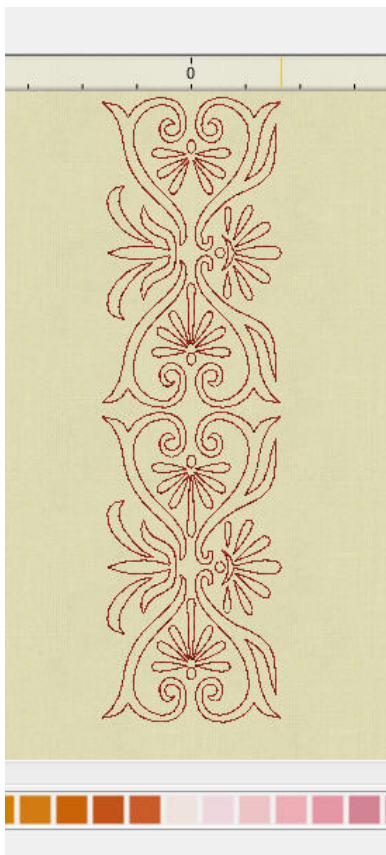
14. Zoom in on the design by clicking on the *Zoom in* button  on the left toolbar and dragging a box around the first large repeat of the outline pattern at the top of the screen.



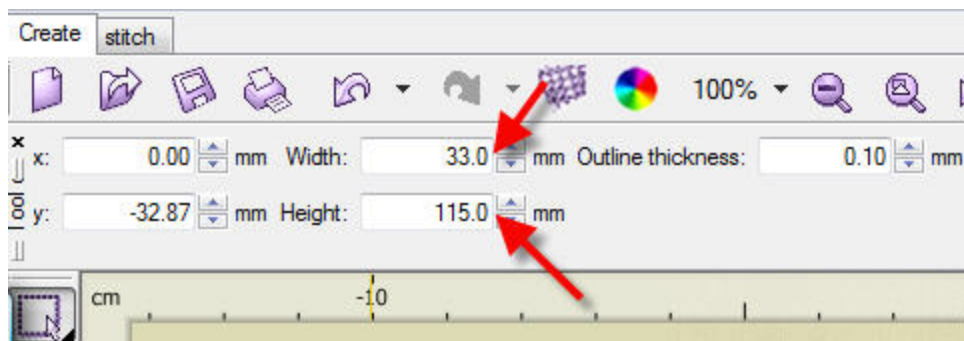
15. When you are zoomed in, left click on the *Selection* box  on the upper left toolbar. Left click and drag a box around the first repeat to select it.

16. Press the *Delete* key on the keyboard to remove the selection.

17. Left click on the *Zoom all* button  on the top toolbar.



18. Select the entire design by left clicking on *Edit* and *Select All* as you did in step 8.
19. On the toolbar at the top of the screen, you can see the properties of the Selection tool. Change the size of the design by typing in the following dimensions: 33mm for the width and 115mm for the height.



20. Save the design in the machine format of your choice.

**Supply List:**

- Schmetz Embroidery Needle Size 90
- Sticky stabilizer
- 2 "Ultrasuede® or felt
- Steam-A-Seam 2®
- Press Cloth
- 2 Sets Snap Source® Snaps
- Mega Sheen embroidery thread

**Finished Size:** 1-5/8" x 8"

**Sewing Instructions:**

1. Hoop sticky stabilizer, sticky side up, in the 126 X 100 machine-embroidery hoop.
2. Mark the center of the embroidery on the Ultrasuede.
3. Place the Ultrasuede in the hoop on the sticky stabilizer with the embroidery placement mark in the center of the hoop.
4. Position the machine needle over the center starting point.
5. Embroider the design.
6. Remove the hoop from the machine and carefully pull the embroidery away from the stabilizer.
7. Remove the paper from one side of the Steam-a-Seam2. Position it on the wrong side of the embroidered Ultrasuede with the long edges aligned. Press to adhere the fusible web to the suede.
8. Peel away the backing paper and place the remaining piece of Ultrasuede on top of the web, cover with a press cloth and fuse in place.
9. Topstitch 1/4" from the raw edges of the wristband.
10. Apply top snaps on one end of the embroidered wristband.
11. Mark and attach corresponding snaps on the other end of the wristband.
